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ABSTRACT

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Key Words: Character, Education Values, Kemendiknas, and “Aquaman” Movie.

The researcher uses KEMENDIKNAS's formulation to analyze character educational values, intrinsic literature and relation of them in the script of movie “Aquaman” by James Wan. The purposes of doing this research are to find out (i) recognize the types of character education values found in the Aquaman movie, (ii) recognize the character education values found in the Aquaman movie will possibly grow student motivation.

In this research, the researcher used library research by approaching descriptive qualitative method. The data of this research are character educational values in the conversation among the characters of the “Aquaman” movie. The data source in this research is a movie entitled “Aquaman”.

The result shows that there are 15 types of character educational value spoken by the characters. Then, the most dominant educational values in this movie are responsible and peacemaker value.



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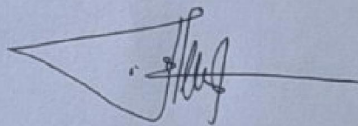
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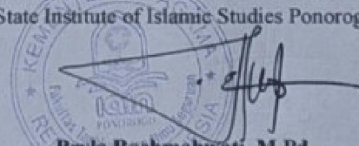
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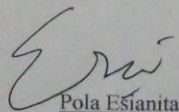
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CHAPTER I

Based on the research by Misbachul Anam Irvani student of State Islamic Institute (IAIN) of Tulungagung, had conducted a research entitled “Character Educational Values in “*The Ron Clark Story*” Movie”⁶ that proofs there are many character educational values in “The Ron Clark Story” movie directed by Randa Haines. In his thesis, he analyzed 18 character education stated by “KEMENDIKNAS” formulation. From the 18 character educational values above, he got 13 character educational values in “The Ron Clark Story” that are honesty, tolerance, dicipline, hard working, creativity, democratic, curiosity, love homeland, appreciating achievement, friendly, like to read, sociality, and responsibility. In the other hand, 5 of 18 character educational values were not appeared on this movie. That are religious, independent, national spirit, love peace, and environmental care.

Aquaman is one of movie that also has a lot of character educational values for the audience. This movie direced by James Wan and produced by Warner Bros Pictures. From Aquaman movie, the researcher finds something which interest. Started with born upon the shores of the surface world, Arthur Curry discovers that he is only half human with the other half of his blood being of atlantean descent, thus

CHAPTER II

PREVIOUS RESEARCH FINDINGS AND THEORITICAL BACKGROUND

A. Previous Research Findings

In this era, conducting a research in movie or film for education is not something new. There are many researchers that conduct a research in movie to observe the characters, values, even to use it for educational purposes. Here, the writer finds some relevant researchers with his research.

The first is thesis of Selvy Dwi Suryanti⁸ a student of English Education Departement. Faculty of Tarbiyah and Teacher Training, State Islamic University (UIN) Raden Intan Lampung, entitled “AN ANALYSIS OF EDUCATIONAL VALUES IN ‘LIFE OF PI’ MOVIE”. Based on this research, the researcher found educational values in the movie are : purity, never give up, not selfish, religious, loyalty, grateful, respect, peace, diligent. In the explanation before, we can find some examples of dialogue shown educational values found in the *Life of Pi* movie. The value can be presented in educational value depend on people itself how they define it. We have to know that there are nine educational values found in *Life of Pi* movie. From the data acquired before, in this study, never give up are dominant educational values that found in this

B. Theoretical Background

1. Component of Movie as Literature

a. Character

In the story, character and characterization is important element to support what the story tells about. Character and characterization also cannot be separated from plot. In the movie, the audience always asking and curious what will happend to the characters. According to DiYanni, the relationship between character and plot can be described as "Plot and character, in fact, are insparable: we are often less concerned with "what happend" than with "what happend to him or her.". We want to know not just "how did it work out," but "how did it work out for them?"¹⁰

According to DiYanni, characterization can be described as, "Characterization is the means by which writers present and reveal character." Characterization and character is different thing. A characterizaation in the film is created a character. The author created characterization to brings and makes some character. To develop a

character according to what the author wants, author using characterization as a method. The author show the character in the film for audience to know more about the character's personality.¹¹

Characters prove to be highly complex objects in a number of ways. They remind one of real persons, but at the same time they seem to consist of mediated signs only. They are 'there' but they do not appear to exist in reality – we do not meet them on the streets, after all. They do exert an influence on us, but we cannot interact with them directly. They are incredibly versatile, they change over time and appear in different forms in different media.¹²

Kennedy states that “A character is an imagined person who inhabits a story – although that simple definition may admit to a few exceptions.” In the novel by George Stewart entitled *Storm*, the wind as a protagonist; the rabbit is the main character in the novel by Richard Adams 'Watership Down'. But usually, we expect human personalities that become familiar to us in the main character. If the story seems “true to life”, we generally find that it's character act consistent manner and reasonable because the author provided them with motivation: sufficient reason to behave as they do. Should a character behave in a sudden and unexpected way, seeming to deny

what we have been told about his nature or personality, we trust that he had a reason and that sooner or late we will discover it.¹³

Character that can be personalized tend to trigger more emotional involvement and more tolerance for change and development (they are therefore comparable to what is called a 'round' and 'dynamic' character in structuralist approaches). Categorized characters, in contrast, tend to be a reliable representatives of a property, and are likely to attract increased attention only when information is presented that does not fit the category, for this will make the recipient aware of his or her previously unconscious inferencing. Generally, information encountered in the text.¹⁴

Generally, characters take a role in the functions of the media they are part of, as for entertainment purposes, artistic purposes, education, information, distribution of ideologies, or advertising. The other functions are media-specific: in novels or feature films, they as primarily narrative purposes, whereas in board games or video games their ludic purposes seem to be able to perform certain moves with them.¹⁵

b. Plot

The term plot refers to the action or “storyline” of the literary work. the plot must have in Drama and fiction, but sometimes poems do also. The art of the plot usually involves conflict between two or more characters or between a character and their self. Generally, the plot of drama or fiction has a particular pattern, which includes the exposition: where the conflict or action begins, the rising action: the events that promote the conflict, the climax: the point of greatest emotional tension in the work, and the resolution or denouement: where the loose ends are wrapped up.¹⁶

Plot will mean the artistic arrangement or those events. Different arrangements of the same material are possible. A writer might decide to tell of the events in chronological event order, beginning with the earliest; or he might open his story with the last event, then tell what let up to it.¹⁷

The element of plot :

1. Exposition

Exposition is the presentation of the information necessary for the plot to get under way. It is the introduction to the characters, their relationship with one another, and the physical

background in which they find themselves and so on. The exposition happens when Jamal is tortured by two police in a police office. The police interrogate Jamal in his room to explain how he knew the answers of all questions in the quiz. And the other scenes Jamal follows the quiz of Who Wants to Be a Millionaire and Prem Kumar, the host of the quiz, introduces Jamal as a chai walla or tea server.¹⁸

2. Conflict

The conflict may be one of humans against nature, human against each other or in the mind of the chief character, man against himself. The conflict happens in the studio quiz when Jamal tries to answer questions one by one based on the experience of Jamal's childhood. Every Prem reads the question to Jamal. The conflicts happen in Jamal himself. Sometimes Jamal can answer the question and sometime he can't. In the second question Jamal uses to ask the audience lifeline because he can't answer the second question. In the question number seven, Jamal uses "50:50" lifeline because he is confused with his answer. He is confused because Prem gives him the answer of the question in the bathroom. He knows that Prem tries to sabotage him. The last question Jamal uses his last lifeline, "phone a

3. Climax

The climax is a core of crisis or turning back point in the whole action of a plot. It is the point at which the fatal step is taken the essential decision made which results in the action concluding one way or another. The climax from *Slumdog Millionaire* Movie happen when Jamal waiting Latika in rail station. Latika attempt to rendezvous with Jamal, but she recaptured by Javed's men, led by Salim. One of the men slashes his cheek with a knife as Salim drives off with her in his car, leaving Jamal behind, furious and disappointed. Jamal lost Latika again.

4. Resolution

The resolution is the conclusion of the whole of the story from the action, one way or the other of the conflict. In the storyline, the resolution is referred to as the end catastrophe or means explanation the end of the story.¹⁹

c. Setting

The definition of setting is information about the time, space, and atmosphere of the behavior in a literary work..²⁰

According to Dana, the setting of a story means where time and place happened. Dana added that "The world might remind you of the metal that holds a diamond in a ring, or of a set used in a play – perhaps a bare chair in front of a slab of painted canvas. But often, in an effective short story, the setting may figure as more than mere background or underpinning. It can make things happen. It can prompt characters too."²¹

To be clear, the idea of setting includes where a story takes place: a house, a street, a city, a landscape, a region. Physical places mattered so greatly sometimes. Before writing a story places, the writer would visit that many places, select a few houses, and describe them in detail, down to their very smells. "The place in which sin event occurred, " Henry James admiringly stated of him, "was in his view of an equal moment with the event itself ... it had a part to play; it needed to be made as definite as anything else".

But besides places, the setting may be complicated involve the time of the story – hour, year, or century. It is very important to choose a story that takes place. Is at dawn? or on the day of the first moon landing. When we started to study a historical novel, we are soon made aware that we aren't reading about life in the 1990s.

In *The Scarlet Letter*, Nathaniel Hawthorne as a nineteenth-century

We can appreciate the shocking agitation in town when a woman is accused of adultery: she has given illegitimate birth.²²

2. Education Values

Education values is education in the concern with the development of the total personality of the individual intellectual, social, emotional asthetic, moral and spiritual. It involves developing sensivity to the good, the right and beautiful, ability to choose the right values in accordance with the thought and action. In a row education values is to develop rational critical thinking, to educate the emotions, to cultivate the imagination.²³

According to Michael Farrel, education is the manner and effort to increase human knowledge, skill also experience to continued their life. Humans in an attempt to maintain the continuation of life bequeathed various cultural values from one generation to the next generation. Consecutively education is imporant to knowledge, to

According to Fraenkle, a value is an idea concept about what someone thinks is important in life. Earle William James says that values is the positive quality of anything that is desirable, useful, interesting, good and important, to name only a few of the terms available for the expression of the positive values. When a person values something, he or she seems to be worth work, worth having, worth doing or anything to be obtained.²⁷

According to Selvy Dwi Suranti, values of giving is that values need to be practiced or provided which would then be accepted as a given. Values of giving include:

a. Loyalty

Loyalty is the condition quality of being loyal, faithfulness to commitments, or responsible. Loyal can be indicated to family, to work, to the school, and organizations and other institutions are responsible for us. A loyalty people were usually ready to support, ready to serve, ready to help, and trusted in carrying out consistent promises. Characteristics of trustworthiness are honest, be reliable, have the courage to do the right thing, build a good reputation, be loyal.

b. Respect

Love and affection is a positive feeling you may have or express for other people or things. Affection define as a feeling of liking and caring for someone or something. Love is more than just a loyal and respectful. Love can be indicated to dear friends, dear to neighbor, who also love to hate us. And emphasizes the lifelong responsibility for saying to the family.

d. Not Selfishness

Not selfishness is a feeling where cares and considers to others. Not selfish is one attitude that more care to others. Not selfish is one attitude that more care to others, learn to feel the togetherness and compassion toward others. Not selfish usually shown by

empathy, tolerance, and brotherhood. Sensitive is having a cute mental or emotional sensibility, aware of responsive to the feeling of others.

e. Kind and Friendly

Kind is good attitude having people to others or things. It is aware friendly and caring attitude is more commendable than the rough and tough attitude. It can be shown by tenderness, especially on the younger or weaker. Capable of making new friends and maintain friendships.

f. Fair and Humanist

Fair is treating someone in the right way or reasonable or treating a group of people in the same way. Fair is not let personal opinion to influence judgment. On the other side, fair define as agreeing with what is thought to be right or acceptable. About humane is characterized by tenderness, compassion, and sympathy for people or things. Films provide a narrative model framed in emotions and imagine that is also grounded in the students’ familiar, everyday universe.” In other words, this study focuses the notion that when the goal is promoting reflection that includes both emotional and cognitive components, life histories derived from the films are well-matched with the students’ desires and expectations. Learning through aesthetics in which cinema is included stimulates a reflective attitude in the learner. Emotions make learning both more memorable and more pleasurable for students. Generally, movies along with television, video games, music, and the internet are regarded as one of the most effective tools in giving pleasure to its target group.

According to Richard & Dave³¹, there are three major types of movies:

- a. Narrative

Narrative is a way of how to create fictional or fictionalized stories presented in narrative films. Storytelling is a complicated business, especially when relating a multifaceted story involving multiple characters and conflicts over the course of two hours of screen time. Besides being a general tool for a story or for a kind of movie, usually narrative is used to describe the way that movie stories are built and presented to engage, involve, and orient an audience. This narrative structure—which includes exposition, rising action, climax, falling action, and denouement—helps filmmakers manipulate the viewer's cinematic experience by selectively conforming to or diverging from audience expectations of storytelling.

b. Documentary

The documentary movie has a purpose to educate the viewer. The documentary has to recording real events or present political or social analyses. In other words, if we think of a narrative movie as fiction, then the best way to understand the documentary movie is as non - fiction. So, it can be concluded that a documentary should be based on a real story.

c. Experimental

Experimental is the most difficult of all types of movies to define precisely. Because experimental filmmakers actively seek to defy categorization and convention. For starters, it's

helpful to think of experimental cinema as pushing the boundaries of what most people think movies are—or should be.

4. Aquaman Movie

Aquaman is a superhero film based on the DC Comics superhero of the same name. It is the sixth film in the DC Extended Universe. It was released on December 21, 2018. The film is directed by James Wan.

Starting in Maine, 1985, lighthouse keeper Tom Curry rescues Atlanna, the princess of the underwater nation of Atlantis, and they fall in love. Then, they have a son namely Arthur Curry. Arthur is born with the power to communicate with marine lifeforms. Someday, Atlanna is forced to abandon her family and return to Atlantis, entrusting to her loyal advisor Nuidis Vulko the mission of training Arthur. Arthur becomes a skilled warrior under Vulko's guidance, but he was rejected by the Atlanteans for being a half breed and ultimately leaves Atlantis behind.

One year after steppenwolf's invasion, Arthur confronts pirates led by Jesse Kane, who are in the middle of a Russian nuclear submarine hijacking. Kane is killed during the confrontation, and his son, David Kane vows revenge against Arthur. A second Russian submarine, in retaliation, strikes Atlantis, but Arthur's half brother King Orm, quickly destroys it and uses the seemingly unprovoked attack as a

pretext to declare war on the surfaces. Nereus, ruler of the kingdom of Xebel, supports him, but Nereus' daughter Mera, who has been betrothed to Orm, refuses to aid them and journeys to the surface to ask Arthur for help, earning his trust by saving Tom from a tidal wave sent by Orm. Arthur reluctantly accompanies Mera to a rendezvous with Vulko, who urges Arthur to find the trident of Atlan, a magic artifact that once belonged to Atlantis' first ruler, in order to reclaim his rightful place as king. They are ambushed by Orm's men. Mera and Vulko escape, while Arthur is captured.

Orm visits Arthur in captivity and announces that Atlanna was executed for the crime of having a half-breed son, blaming Arthur and the surface for her death. He offers Arthur an opportunity to leave forever, but Arthur instead challenges him to a duel in the Ring of Fire. Orm gains the upper hand and nearly kills Arthur before Mera rescues him. Together, Arthur and Mera journey to the Sahara desert, where the trident was forged and unlock a holographic message that leads them to Sicily, where they retrieve the trident's coordinates.

Meanwhile, Orm provides David with Atlantean armor and weaponry and sends him to stop them, imprisons Vulko upon learning of his betrayal, and coerces the remaining five kingdoms of Atlantis to pledge allegiance to him and his campaign against the surface.

In Sicily, Arthur and Mera are ambushed by David, who fights and injures Arthur before being thrown off a cliff to his apparent death.

Mera nurses Arthur's wounds as they journey to the trident's whereabouts, and encourages him to embrace his destiny as a hero. Arriving at their destination, Arthur and Mera are attacked by a legion of amphibious monsters known as the Trench, but manage to fend them off and reach a wormhole that transports them to an uncharted sea located at the center of the earth. There, they unexpectedly reunited with Atlanna, who was sacrificed to the Trench for her crimes, but manage to escape them and reach the uncharted sea, where she has been stranded ever since.

Arthur faces Karathen, the mythical leviathan that guards the trident, and voices his determination to protect both Atlantis and the surface, proving his worth and reclaiming the trident, which grants him control over the seven seas. Arthur, Mera, and Atlanna lead an army of Marine creatures in battle against Orm and his followers, who renounce their obedience to Orm and trident. Arthur defeats Orm in combat, but chooses to spare his life, and Orm accepts his fate after discovering Arthur has found and rescued their mother. Atlanna returns to the surface to reunite with Tom, while Arthur ascends to the throne, with Mera by his side, and embraces his fate as Aquaman.³²

5. The Biography of the Director

James Wan was born on 26 February 1977. He is an Australian film producer, screenwriter, and film director of Malaysian Chinese

descent.³³ Before James Wan found success in the mainstream film industry, he made his first feature – length films, *Stygian* alongside Shannon Young, which won the ‘Best Guerrilla Film’ at the Underground Film Festival in 2000. Wan rose to fame then he collaborated with fellow Australian, screenwriter and director, Leigh Whannell to write a script for a horror film, deriving inspiration from their dreams and fears. The script they wrote later came to be known as *Saw*, which went to become one of the biggest success both in America and internationally. The film, which grossed over US \$103 million worldwide, the producers made a profit of over 80 times the production cost.

After creating the *Saw* franchise, both Wan and Whannell worked together as executive producers for *Saw II*, *Saw III*, *Saw IV*, *Saw V*, *Saw VI* and *Saw 3D: The final Chapter*. In 2007, Wan directed two feature films, *Dead Silence*, and *Death Sentence*.

Dead Silence, which features Australian actor, Ryan Kwanten is about a ghost of a ventriloquist, Mary Shaw who removes the tongue of any person who screams in her presence. *Death Sentence* is an adaptation from Brain Garfield’s novel of the same name. The movie is about a father played by Kevin Bacon who seeks to take revenge for his murdered son, who is killed by a local gangster. Wan described “the move as ‘It’s my arthouse movie with guns.’”

Wan, next directed *Insidious*, which premiered at the 2010 Toronto International Film Festival and released in theaters in April 2011. The film was a super hit and it was the third highest – grossing movie at the box office that year; the movie made US \$13.5 million in ticket sales. Post the release of *Insidious*, Wan stated in an interview that if he finds some good material, he would do action and romantic comedy movies. But, Wan continued his horror movie directing streak and in February 2012 he stated working on *The Conjuring*. The movie, which released in July 2013 received great acclaim from both audience and critics.

While working on *The Conjuring*, Wan stated working on a sequel to 2010's *Insidious* titled *Insidious: Chapter 2*, which released in September 2013. In early 2013, Wan began negotiating with Universal Pictures to direct the seventh installment of the *Fast and Furious* franchise. Wan got the final confirmation to direct *Furious 7* in April 2013 and two years later when the movie released in April 2015 it became the most successful film in the *Fast and Furious* in terms of box office collections and critic reviews.

In 2016, Wan directed the second installment in the *Conjuring* series, titled *The Conjuring 2*. The film, which had Vera Farmiga and Patrick Wilson reprising their roles from the first installment, was a critical and commercial success, grossing over \$320 million at the box office. The filmmaker subsequently debuted in the DC Extended Universe

by helming the superhero movie Aquaman (2018), which featured Jason Momoa in the titular role.³⁴

CHAPTER III

RESEARCH DESIGN

A. Research Design

Research design is a process of steps used to collect and analyze information to increase our understanding of a topic or issue.³⁵ In conducting this research, the researcher uses the library research and the approach that is used by the writer is descriptive qualitative.

Kothari³⁶ stated that “qualitative approach to research is concerned with subjective assessment of attitudes, opinions and behaviour.” To analyze the data, the researcher used content analysis. Content analysis is one of many types of analyzing data in qualitative research. In addition, the researcher uses library research because the researcher uses document to be analyzed that is from screenplay of movie. The researcher uses descriptive qualitative because the researcher wants to describe and analyze the character educational values in “Aquaman” movie.

B. Data Source

Data source is subject to find out where the data come from. Data source generally categorized as non – verbal and

1. Primary Source

In analyzing “Aquaman” movie, there are two data sources for the analysis, the “Aquaman” movie video and screenplay. The primary source of the data is the video and screenplay of “Aquaman” movie. The file of the movie video is downloaded from www.Ganool.com. The movie becomes subject of the analysis where the writer follows the actions of the main actor and all of characters to find the character education values in “Aquaman” movie.

2. Secondary Source

Secondary source is analyze the character educational values in “Aquaman” movie based on KEMENDIKNAS’s formulation. There are 18 types of character educational values taken from KEMENDIKNAS’s formulation, includes: religiosity, honesty, tolerance, dicipline, hardworking, creativity, independent, democracy, curiosity, national spirit, patriotism, highly regard

achievement, friendly/communicative, peace maker, good reader, environmental care, sociality, and responsibility.

C. Technique of Data Collection

In conducting this research, the researcher uses documentary technique to collect the data by getting the data from reading the movie screenplay and watching of “Aquaman” movie by James Wan.

Actually, documentary technique is the technique to collect data and the data usually from transcript, books, newspaper, magazine, script, etc.³⁷

In this research, the researcher necessary following steps to collecting the data as follows:

- 1) Downloading the movie script.
- 2) Watching the movie more than once.
- 3) Reading and observing the dialogue from the subtitle.
- 4) Collecting the data by watching the movie and trying to understand it deeply and looking for all utterances.
- 5) Classifying them into categories of character educational values based on KEMENDIKNAS’s formulation.
- 6) Selecting the every scene and utterance in the movie into character educational values.

D. Technique of Data Analysis and Interpretation

The researcher describes the result of research by watching and understanding the screenplay of Aquaman movie accurately. Then, analyze the character educational values in the movie. Explained the character educational values by identifying screenplay and scenes. By watching, understanding the screenplay, collecting theory from library and internet. The researcher begins to identifying data from the movie, then watching it and understanding the screenplay to analyze character education values that expressed in Aquaman movie. After that, the researcher collecting reference that relevant to analysis then all the information valid to the topic of discussion transcribes.

CHAPTER IV

FINDING AND ANALYSIS

A. General data

In this research the researcher referred to the “AQUAMAN” movie script. The description of the movie can be seen in the following :

1. Aquaman Movie

Aquaman was written and created by Mort Weisinger, and illustrated by Paul Norris. Weisinger also known as creator of Superman. Aquaman appeared in television in 1969-1968 and in numerous animated versions of Super Friends starting in 1973. He also known as a character in the live-action television drama Smallville (2001) and as the featured character in the made for television movie Aquaman (2006). Aquaman made his feature film debut in Justice League (2017).³⁸

Aquaman movie was released on November, 2018 based on the DC Comics character of the same name and distributed by Warner Bros. In the movie, Aquaman sets out to lead the Atlantis kingdom of underwater replacing his half brother King Orm who create to unite the seven underwater kingdoms against the surface world.³⁹

2. The Biography of the Director

1) James Wan

James Wan was born in 26 February 1977. He is a film director from the horror series Saw. Wan studied film at the Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology, where he met his screenwriting partner Leigh Whannell. They put together a sample of Saw and went to Los Angeles to find partner productions. Saw brings Wan to win the nomination of the best screening at the Sundance Film Festival led to a distribution deal in 2004, and the \$700,000 movie made more than \$18 million in first week.


After success with the series of Saw, Wan turned to other pursuits, including the less gory horror films Dead Silence (2007), Death Sentence (2007), Insidious (2010), The Conjuring (2013) and The Conjuring 2 (2016). However, he stepped away from horror to the film action Fast & Furious 7, which became a huge box office hit. After directed Furious 7 success, he signs with Warner Bros and make deal with him to direct Aquaman movie. Aquaman premiered in London on November, 2018 and was released in US on December. It grossed over \$1.1 billion worldwide, making it the highest grossing film based on a DC comics character.

The conclusion above is supported by the following picture and dialogue:



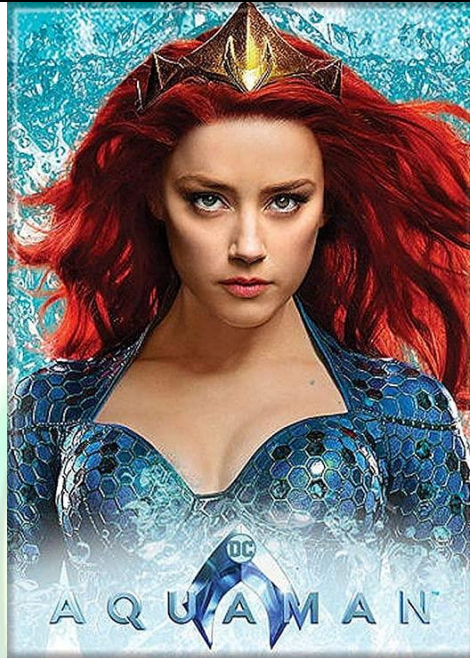
Arthur : Here hold this!

After the research gets the data, the

researcher analyzes the data and interprets the data. After the researcher read “Aquaman” movie, the researcher found 15 utterances of the characters that contains of character educational value. The utterances are honesty, tolerance, discipline, hardworking, creativity, curiosity, national spirit, patriotism, friendly/communicative, peacemaker, environmental care, responsibility, loyalty, respect, love & affection. Among the characters exist in “Aquaman” movie.

The researcher focused on 7 main character only. They are Arthur Curry, Princess Mera, Queen Atlana, Nuidis Vulko, Tom Curry, King Orm and King Nereus.

2) The Most dominant Character Educational Values in Aquaman Movie

In the Aquaman movie, the most dominant character educational values is responsible and peacemaker value. Some scenes that explain responsible in the movie, such as:

First, when King Orm gave Arthur a chance to leave Atlantis, because Arthur could not defeat him. And he told Arthur for not stop him to attack the surface. Arthur refused it and keep challenge him. (*performed 00:58:50-00:59:15*). It can be concluded that Arthur has responsible value to keep world save from war.

Second, Arthur helped and guided people into the cruch to avoid Black Manta's attack. (*performed 01:31:55-01:32:09*) . It can be concluded that this scenes contained responsible to help each other.

Third, In the midnight Arthur was sparated from his father in tsunami disaster and Mera helped to find him. After finding his father, Arthur was very panicked because he was not breathing. Mera helped Arthur's father with her super power and finally his father survived.(*performed 00:35:19-00:36:02*). It can be concluded hat Mera has responsible value to help each other.

Some scenes that show peacemaker value in the movie, such as:

First, when Arthur and King Orm fought on land. Then, Arthur defeat King Orm. King Orm was really dissapointed and told arthur to kill him. Atlanna comes then interrupts the two of them and says if she loves them both.(*performed 02:07:39-02:08:20*). It can be concluded that Atlanna has love and peacemaker values.

Second, Arthur and Mera arrived in Atlantis and met Vulko secretly. They are discussed the plan to stop King Orm's attack. Vulko tells the legend of King Atlan's trident and ask Arthur and Mera look for the royal trident. With that trident Arthur can take the throne as king of Atlanis and preserve the peace. (*performed 00:44:48-00:45:12*). It can be concluded that Atlanna has love and peacemaker values.

CHAPTER V

DISCUSSION

This chapter presents the script of the movie ideas to the researcher in interpreting the research findings. This part will focus in interpreting the relationship among patterns found in data analysis. In addition, this chapter also explains the position of findings of the present research in the theories, which are relevant. It will devices found in Aquaman movie.

A. The Character Educational Value are Found in “Aquaman” Movie Directed by James Wan

From this analysis, the researcher founds 15 character educational values in Aquaman movie, there are: are honesty, tolerance, dicipline, hardworking, creativity, curiosity, national spirit, patriotism, friendly/communicative, peacemaker, environmental care, responsibility, loaylity, respect, love & afferction. However, the dominant character education values in the movie is responsible, and peacemaker.

B. The Character Educational Value in Fragments of “Aquaman” Movie Directed by James Wan

In this study, the researcher focuses on utterances in term of character educational values that spoken by characters. There are 15 types of character educational values spoken by the characters

which the researcher found by in “Aquaman” movie directed by James Wan:

1. Respect is a positive feeling or action that is shown to someone or something that is considered important or is held in high esteem. It conveys admiration for a good or valuable thing. Respect can show with an action or spoken way.⁴⁰ The example, Arthur loves his father so much. When a tsunami comes, Arthur was separated from his father and Mera helped him. Finally, they found his father. But Tom was not breathing. Mera helped Tom with her superpower. Then, Tom awake and Arthur was very grateful to Mera.
2. Loyalty is an action to shows the support and participation of someone or something expected. Loyalty to someone can be interpreted by an act of helping people who need help. It can be shown as a representation of friendship. The example is King Orm had planned to be an ocean master, then attack the surface world. He did it because he thought the surface people had polluted the sea. Before the ocean was damaged, he planned to stop it. Mera asked Arthur to help her prevent King Orm’s planing. Arthur finally agrees to help her.
3. Patriotism value is an attitude that is brave, underlying, and willing to bleed for the nation and state. In other words,

5. Hardworking is inclined to do anything and try hard to be able to achieve the target of dreams or goals. Hardworking can be interpreted as an activity that is done in earnest without training. Hardworking will never stop before the target work is achieved and always prioritizes or pays attention to the results that have been done. For the example is Vulko asks Arthur to master everything that Vulko had to

The example is Arthur and King Orm prepared for Ring Fire. While waiting, King Orm told legend of Karathen. Then, Arthur says that sometimes he wants to know King Orm as his little brother and tells that he was not alone.

7. Responsibility is the sense to assume or give duty and bear the consequences. A sense of responsibility rises because humans are aware of the good and bad consequences of their actions. Besides that, sometimes humans realize they will need to sacrifice. The example is King Orm gave Arthur a chance to leave Atlantis because he could not defeat him. King Orm asked Arthur not to prevent him to attack the surface. He refused it and keep challenge King Orm.

8. Creativity value also known as ability to think and act using knowledge, experience, understanding, common sense and insight. In the other words, wisdom can be interpreted as activity based on experimental self knowledge and self transcendence.⁴² The example is Arthur communicates with the whale to get in the whale's mouth imitate Pinnochio.
9. National spirit value. National spirit is creating and maintaining the sovereignty of a country by realizing a concept of shares identity of human organizations that have the same goals or ideals in realizing national interests. National spirit is also a sense of wanting to defend the country both internally and externally. The example is Mera knows about King Orm's declare to attack surface world and she does not let it happend. Mera looking for Arthur to help her stop it.

Education is the most appropriate tool in providing knowledge, skills, and attitude of environmental care to humans.
